

## Materials and tools:

Yarn YarnArt Angora Ram

1.5mm hook

Black beads for eyes

White thread for embroidery eye proteins

Black thread for embroidering the nose

Needle and scissors

Hollofiber

Description of crocheting a bear

Legend:

sbn - single crochet

ss - connecting column

pr - increase (2 columns in one loop of the previous row)

Ub - decrease (2 columns with one vertex)

There is no knitting pattern for panties and overalls for a teddy bear in the description.

## Head

1 - 6 sb in the amigurumi ring

2 - 6 pr (12)

3 - (1 sbn, pr) \* 6 (18)

4 - (2 PRS, D) \* 6 (24)

5 - (3 prs, pr) \* 6 (30)

6 - (4 PRS, D) \* 6 (36)

7 - (5 prs, pr) \* 6 (42)

8 - (6 prs, pr) \* 6 (48)

9 - (7 PRS, D) \* 6 (54)

10 - (8 prs, pr) \* 6 (60)

11 - (9 prs, pr) \* 6 (66)

12-25 - 66 sb (66) - 14 rows

26 - (9 SBN, UB) \* 6 (60)

27 - (8 PRS, UB) \* 6 (54)

28 - (7 PRS, UB) \* 6 (48)

29 - (6 sb, ub) \* 6 (42)

30 - (5 sb, ub) \* 6 (36)

31 - (4 PRS, UB) \* 6 (30)

To fill. Fasten the thread, leave the tip for sewing.

Sew the eyes on about 21-22 rows.

## Muzzle

1 - 6 sb in the amigurumi ring

2 - 6 pr (12)

3 - (1 sbn, pr) \* 6 (18)

4 - (2 PRS, D) \* 6 (24)

5-6 - we knit 24 sbn (24) - 2 rows

Fasten the thread, cut. Leave the tip for sewing

## Legs (2 parts)

1 - 6 sb in the amigurumi ring

2 - 6 pr (12)  
3 - (2 PRS, D) \* 4 (16)  
4-7 - 16 sbn (16) - 4 rows  
Fasten and cut the thread.

Tie the second leg in the same way, but do not cut the thread.

#### Torso

We continue to knit. We collect 5 air loops on the second leg and attach the first leg to ss.

We stuff the part in the process of knitting.

1 - we knit 16 sbn on the first leg, 5 sbn on the air loops, 15 sbn on the second leg, 5 sbn on the air loops on the back side (42)  
2 - 17 sbn, 3 pr, 18 sbn, 3 pr, 1 sbn (48)  
3 - (7 PRS, D) \* 6 (54)  
4 - (8 prs, pr) \* 6 (60)  
5 - (9 prs, pr) \* 6 (66)  
6-17 - we knit 66 sbn (66) - 12 rows  
18 - (9 SBN, UB) \* 6 (60)  
19-20 - we knit 60 sbn (60)  
21 - (8 PRS, UB) \* 6 (54)  
22-23 - we knit 54 sbn (54) - 2 rows  
24 - (7 PRS, UB) \* 6 (48)  
25-26 - we knit 48 sbn (48) - 2 rows  
27 - (6 sb, ub) \* 6 (42)  
28-29 - we knit 42 sbn (42) - 2 rows  
30 - (5 sb, ub) \* 6 (36)  
31-32 - we knit 36 sbn (36)  
33 - (4 PRS, UB) \* 6 (30)  
34 - we knit 30 sbn (30)  
We fix the thread and cut it.

#### Hands (2 parts)

We stuff in the knitting process

1 - 6 sb in the amigurumi ring  
2 - 6 pr (12)  
3 - (1 sbn, pr) \* 6 (18)  
4-5 - we knit 18 sbn (18) - 2 rows  
6 - 6 sbn, 3 ub, 6 sbn (15)  
7 - (3 PRS, UB) \* 3 (12)  
8-19 - we knit 12 sbn - 12 rows  
20 - fold in half and knit both sides together 6 sbn (6)  
Fasten the thread, leave the tip for sewing. Crop.

#### Ears (2 parts)

1 - 6 sb in the amigurumi ring  
2 - 6 pr (12)  
3 - we knit 12 sbn (12)  
We fix the thread, leave a little for sewing.

#### Design and assembly

Sew the ears on about 12-13 row.  
Sew the muzzle (we stuff a little).  
We make out the eyes, nose.

Sew on the head, then the handles, backing 2-3 rows from the head.  
Bear is ready!
