

Free amigurumi pattern to create a 20 inch (52 cm) plush fox in dress. To crochet this cute fox you will need Himalaya Dolphin Baby or YarnArt Dolce yarn and 4.00 mm crochet hook.

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Translated by Amiguroom Toys

Materials:

1 skein Himalaya Dolphin Baby, 100 g/120 m (orange color)

1/2 skein Himalaya Dolphin Baby, 100 g/120 m (blue color for dress)

1/3 skein Himalaya Dolphin Baby, 100 g/120 m (white color)

1/3 skein Himalaya Dolphin Baby, 100 g/120 m (black color)

Thin thread in the tone of yarn for sewing details

4.00 mm crochet hook

Sewing needle and scissors

Fiberfill

Abbreviations:

R = row

mc = magic circle

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

st = stitch

DC = double crochet

inc = 2 sc in the next stitch

dec = single crochet 2 stitches together

F.o. = finish off

BLO = back loop only

FLO = front loop only

(12) = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row

()*6 = repeat whatever is between the brackets the number of times stated

Amigurumi fox free crochet plush pattern

Ears (make 2)

With black yarn:

R 1: 4 sc in mc (4)

R 2: inc*4 (8)

R 3: (3 sc, inc)*2 (10)

R 4: (4 sc, inc)*2 (12)

With orange yarn:

R 5: (5 sc, inc)*2 (14)

R 6: (6 sc, inc)*2 (16)

R 7: 16 sc

Fold top of ear flat and sc through both sides across.

F.o.

Muzzle

With orange yarn:

R 1: 4 sc in mc (4)

R 2: inc*4 (8)

R 3: (3 sc, inc)*2 (10)

R 4: (4 sc, inc)*2 (12)

R 5: (5 sc, inc)*2 (14)

R 6: (6 sc, inc)*2 (16)

R 7-8: 16 sc (2 rows)

F.o.

Head

With orange yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: inc*6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc)*6 (18)

R 4: (2 sc, inc)*6 (24)

R 5: (3 sc, inc)*6 (30)

R 6: (4 sc, inc)*6 (36)

R 7: (5 sc, inc)*6 (42)

R 8-15: 42 sc (8 rows)

With white yarn:

R 16: (5 sc, dec)*6 (36)

R 17: (4 sc, dec)*6 (30)

R 18: (3 sc, dec)*6 (24)

R 19: (2 sc, dec)*6 (18)

R 20-21: 18 sc (2 rows)

F.o.

Crochet plush fox amigurumi

Tail

With white yarn:

R 1: 4 sc in mc (4)

R 2: inc*4 (8)

R 3: (3 sc, inc)*2 (10)

R 4: (4 sc, inc)*2 (12)

R 5: (5 sc, inc)*2 (14)

R 6: (6 sc, inc)*2 (16)

With orange yarn:

R 7: 16 sc

R 8: (6 sc, dec)*2 (14)

R 9: (5 sc, dec)*2 (12)

R 10: (4 sc, dec)*2 (10)

R 11: (3 sc, dec)*2 (8)

R 12: 8 sc

Stuff tail $\frac{1}{2}$ full.

Fold top of tail flat and sc through both sides across.

F.o.

Arms (make 2)

With black yarn:

R 1: 7 sc in mc (7)

R 2-6: 7 sc (5 rows)

With orange yarn:

R 7-15: 7 sc (9 rows)

With blue yarn:

R 16-17: 7 sc (2 rows)

Stuff arm $\frac{1}{2}$ full.

Fold top of arm flat and sc through both sides across.

F.o.

Legs (make 2)

With black yarn:

R 1: 10 sc in mc (10)

R 2-7: 10 sc (6 rows)

With orange yarn:

R 8-21: 10 sc (14 rows)

Don't cut the yarn when you will finish the second leg!

From second leg: 8 ch, join with the first leg.

Continue crocheting the body in the round:

R 1: 10 sc on the first leg, 8 sc in 8 ch, 10 sc on the second leg, 8 sc in 8 ch (opposite side) (36)

R 2-3: 36 sc (2 rows)

With blue yarn:

R 4: 36 sc

R 5: BLO 36 sc

R 6-13: 36 sc (8 rows)

R 14: (4 sc, dec)*6 (30)

R 15: 30 sc

R 16: (4 sc, dec)*5 (25)

R 17: 25 sc

R 18: (3 sc, dec)*5 (20)

R 19-21: 20 sc (3 rows)

F.o.

Skirt

With blue yarn:

Go to body R 5.

R 1: FLO: 2 DC in next st * 36 (72)

R 2: 72 sc

F.o.

Bow

With blue yarn:

Make 9 ch. From the 2nd ch from hook:

R 1: 8 sc, 1 turning chain (8)

R 2-5: 8 sc, 1 turning chain (4 rows)

R 6: 8 sc

F.o.

Wrap the middle of the bow multiple times with yarn.

Assembly

Better to sew details to each other with other yarn not with plush one.

1. Sew the muzzle on the head between R 13 and R 17 and embroider a nose.

2. Embroider eyes at R 11.

3. Sew the ears on the head, sew the head on the body.

4. Sew the arms at R 20 of the body.

5. Sew the bow near on the ear.

6. Sew on the tail at R 4.
