Now let's crochet lama amigurumi step by step.

## Necessary materials

1. Himalaya Dolphin baby \# 357 (gray) \# 349 (dusty pink)
2. Wagp Art JEans \# 80 (light gray), and color of your choice for accessories
Z. Hook \# 5, \# 3.25
3. Sew-on eyes
4. Needle
5. Scissors

## Abbreviations

AR - Amigurumi Magic ring
MR - Amigurumi Magic ring
App - application
II - lift loop
sc : Single Crochet
inc: Increase
dec: Decrease
tr : Triple Crochet/ Treble Crochet
st: Stitch
dc: Double Crochet
hdc: Half Double Crochet
sl-st : Slip Stitch
ch: Chain
..in : make increase into same stitch as many as the number which is given in front of "inc"
abbreviation (exp; 3inc, 4inc..).
FLO : Crochet into front loops only
BLO : Crochet into back loops only
BL : Bobble Stitch - do 5dc all in the same stitch and then yarn over and pull through all the loops on your hook (the original loop +1 loop for each partially completed dc).


Body
1.6 sc in Magic ring
2. $6 \mathrm{inc}-12 \mathrm{sc}$
3. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}$ )*6-18 sc
4. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc})^{*} 6-24 \mathrm{sc}$
5. $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 6-30 \mathrm{sc}$
6. $(4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 6-36 \mathrm{sc}$
7. $(5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc})^{*} 6-42 \mathrm{sc}$

8 -17.-42 sc
18. ( $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) ${ }^{6}-36 \mathrm{sc}$
19. ( $4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ )* $6-30 \mathrm{sc}$
20. (3 sc, dec)*6-24 sc
21. (2 sc, dec)*6-18 sc
22. (1 sc, dec)*6-12 sc
23. 6 dec -6 sc
pull off the hole, hide the yarn.

## Ears

1. 6 sc in Magic ring
2. (1sc, inc)*3-9 sc
3. ( $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}$ )*3-12 sc
4. (3 sc, inc)*3-15 sc

5-6. 15 sc
7. ( $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ )*3-12 sc
8. (2 sc, dec)*3-9 sc
9. 9 sc
fold the part in half, stitch it and sew it to the head.

## Muzzle

1. 6 sc in Magic ring

26 inc-12 sc
3. $(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 6-18 \mathrm{sc}$

4-5.18 sc
leave thread for sewing

## Paws (4 pieces)

we begin to crochet with fine yarn

1. 6 sc in Magic ring
2. $6 \mathrm{inc}-12 \mathrm{sc}$
3. $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 3-15 \mathrm{sc}$

4-7. 15 sc
change the thread to plush yarn
8-9. 15 sc
leave thread for sewing

Tail

1. 6 sc in Magic ring
2. 6 sc
3. $(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 3-9 \mathrm{sc}$

4-5. 9 sc
6. Knit 6 more stitches without crochets, make a connecting post, leave the yarn for sewing

## Cape

Crochet in swivel rows at the end of each row we make an air loop

1. we collect 20 air loops +1 lifting loop
2. from the second loop from the hook we knit 20 sc
3. 20 sc
4. 20 sc
change color
5-8. 20 sc
change color
9-12. 20 sc
Fastening the thread, making strings and ringes

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
