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Today I am sharing a wonderful alien amigurumi pattern for you. I think the choice of green color while making <u>amigurumi</u> is based on a once popular video. I remember a video called the alien dance. It had become quite popular. Afterwards, <u>crochet doll</u> amigurumi patterns were started to be made. It is not possible to find many alien <u>doll patterns</u>. Especially English designs are really hard to find. I translated this pattern for you, I hope you like it. Hello dear friends. Today we are crocheting a very cute alien amigurumi. A great alien amigurumi pattern.

## ANOTHER SAVELY

Savely knits very easily and quickly. Yarn was used for knitting. GAZZAL (Gazzal) Baby Cotton.

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#### Abbreviations

AR – Amigurumi Magic ring

MR – Amigurumi Magic ring

App – application

ll – lift loop

sc : Single Crochet

inc : Increase

dec : Decrease

tr : Triple Crochet/ Treble Crochet

st: Stitch

dc : Double Crochet

hdc: Half Double Crochet

sl-st : Slip Stitch

ch : Chain

..in : make increase into same stitch as many as the number which is given in front of "inc" abbreviation (exp; 3inc, 4inc..).

FLO : Crochet into front loops only

BLO : Crochet into back loops only

BL : Bobble Stitch – do 5dc all in the same stitch and then yarn over and pull through all the loops on your hook (the original loop + 1 loop for each partially completed dc).



**Legs** – we knit two parts, then we will connect them with a chain of air loops.

- 1 P: 6 sc in MR
- 2 P: inc\*6 (12)

3 P: (1 sc, inc)\*6 (18)
4 P: (2 sc, inc)\*6 (24)
5 P: 24 sc
6 P: 24 behind the back of the loop
7 P: 24 sc\*2 rows
8 P: (1 sc, dec)\*8 (16)
9 P: (2 sc, dec)\*4 (12)
10-15 P: 12 sc \* 6 rows

We fix the thread, cut it off, knit the second leg of the same. Further, we do not cut the thread. We continue knitting.

We sew the body to the head.

## Hands (knit two parts)

I didn't stuff my hands, only my palms.

 8-18 P: 8 sc \* 11
 P: 4 dec

## Panties

Cast on a chain of 52-55 sc (at your discretion, see that there is enough length to girth at the level of the expected waist), knit in pivoting rows, adding lifting loops: 1 loop in front of a row from sc and three loops in front of a row from dc.

1 P: 52 sc

2 P: 52 sc

3 P: 52 dc

4 P: 52 sc

5 P: 52 dc

And so we alternate until you are satisfied with the length. Next, sew both edges of the canvas, put it on the alien and sew the details between the legs – you get shorts. To make them fit well, you can pass a string along the top edge of the shorts and tie.

#### Antennas (two pieces)

1 P: 6 sc in MR 2 P: inc\*6 (12) 3-6 P: 12 sc\*4 row 7 P: (1 sc, dec)\*4 (8) 8 P: 8 sc \* 5 rows

## Eyes

Here you can improvise: from convex to flat. In the photo, the eyes From dc to CA, before the set of loops, I made 3 lifting loops, 19 dc fit into the circle, try it, it depends on the type of yarn.
