

Hello my dears. Today I want to share a crochet amigurumi pattern that you will like very much. Actually, I will share a crocheted christmas tree pattern, but I don't know how accurate it would be to call it amigurumi. The crochet christmas tree has eyes and a nose so I think we can call it an amigurumi toy. You can use this type of crochet toys especially for decorative purposes. You can visit the christmas patterns category for other amigurumi patterns made for Christmas.

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Materials

- \cdot Chenille yarn (size 4) in Green, Yellow and scraps of other colors
- · 3.5 mm crochet hook(adjust according to your yarn size)
- . 14 mm security eyes
- · Embroidery floss/cotton yarn in black (optional for mouth)
- \cdot Toy stuffing
- \cdot Stitch Marker
- · Tapestry needle
- $\cdot \text{ Scissors}$

Abbreviations

MR – Magic Ring Ch – Chain St/s – Stitch/Stitches Rnd/s – Round/Rounds Slst -Slip Stitch Skp – Skip a stitch Sc – Single Crochet Inc – Increase Dec – Invisible Decrease BLO – Back Loop Only FLO – Front Loop Only



Tree

(in GREEN) Rnd 1: MR 6 sc (6 sts) Rnd 2: BLO (1 sc, 1 inc) x3 (9 sts) Rnd 3: BLO (2 sc, 1 inc) x3 (12 sts) Rnd 4: BLO (3 sc, 1 inc) x3 (15 sts) Rnd 5: BLO (4 sc, 1 inc) x3 (18 sts) Rnd 6: BLO (5 sc, 1 inc) x3 (21 sts) Mark the beginning of rnd 6, so it's easy in the next step Rnd 7: BLO (6 sc, 1 inc) x3 (24 sts) Rnd 8: BLO (7 sc, 1 inc) x3 (27 sts) Rnd 9: BLO (8 sc, 1 inc) x3 (30 sts) Rnd 10: BLO (9 sc, 1 inc) x3 (33 sts) Rnd 11: BLO (10 sc, 1 inc) x3 (36 sts) Mark the beginning of rnd 11, so it's easy in the next step Rnd 12: BLO (11 sc, 1 inc) x3 (39 sts) Rnd 13: BLO (12 sc, 1 inc) x3 (42 sts) Rnd 14: BLO (13 sc, 1 inc) x3 (45 sts) Rnd 15: BLO (14 sc, 1 inc) x3 (48 sts) Rnd 16: BLO (15 sc, 1 inc) x3 (51 sts) Rnd 17: BLO (16 sc, 1 inc) x3 (54 sts) Rnd 18: BLO (17 sc, 1 inc) x3 (57 sts) Rnd 19: BLO (18 sc, 1 inc) x3 (6 0 sts)

Mark the beginning of rnd 11, so it's easy in the next step



Tree (cont.) (in GREEN) Attach the eyes, between rows 13-14, with a distance of 9 sts. Start stuffing and continue as you go.

Rnd 20: BLO (8 sc, 1 dec) x6 (54 sts) Rnd 21: (7 sc, 1 dec) x6 (48 sts) Rnd 22: (4 sc, 1 dec) x8 (40 sts) Rnd 23: (3 sc, 1 dec) x8 (32 sts) Rnd 24: (2 sc, 1 dec) x8 (24 sts) Rnd 25: (1 sc, 1 dec) x8 (16 sts) Rnd 26: 8 dec around (8 sts)



Finish off and sew the hole closed. Embroid the mouth between the eyes. We will now work the 3 rows of scallops, as the tree leaves Attach new yarn on the following rows:

Rnd 6: FLO (1 sc, skp 1, 5 dc in same st, skp 1) x5, Slst. Rnd 11: FLO (1 sc, skp 1, 5 dc in same st, skp 1) x9, Slst Rnd 19: FLO (1 sc, skp 1, 5 dc in same st, skp 1) x15, Slst

Star (in YELLOW) Rnd 1: In MR, (1 sc, 1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc) x5, slst.

Close MR and finish off. Attach to the top of the tree.



Christmas ornaments (Make 10 in various COLORS) Rnd 1: MR 6sc. Close MR and Finish off



Sew it onto the tree.

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
