Materials

DK weight yarn

Yellow

Black

Brown (tail)

Orange (cheek spots)

2.35 mm crochet hook

Poly-fil

Needle

Weighted pellets (optional)

Head

1. With yellow, 8 sc into MR (8)

2. 8 inc (16)

3. (sc, inc) x 8 (24)

4. (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

5. (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

6. (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

7. 42 sc (42)

8. (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)

9-14. (6 rounds) 48 sc (48)

15. (7 sc, inc) x 6 (54)

16-19. (4 rounds) 54 sc (54)

20. (7 sc, dec) x 6 (48)

21. 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec) x 5, 3 sc (42)

22. (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

23. 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) x 5, 2 sc (30)

24. (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

Fasten off and leave a long tail to join to the body

Stuff head with filling

Right Ear

1. With black, 6 sc into MR (6)
 - 2-3. (2 rounds) 6 sc (6)
 4. (sc, inc) x 3 (9)
 5. 7 hdc, 2 sc (9)
 6. 7 dc, 2 sc. Cut black, join yellow (9)
 7. With yellow, (2 sc, inc) x 3 (12)
 - 8-9. (2 rounds) 12 sc (12)
 10. (3 sc, inc) x 3 (15)
 - 11-12. (2 rounds) 15 sc (15)
 13. (4 sc, inc) x 3 (18)
 - 14-15. (2 rounds) 18 sc (18)
- Fasten off and leave a long tail to join to the head. Weave in ends

Left Ear

1. With black, 6 sc into MR (6)
 - 2-3 (2 rounds) 6 sc (6)
 4. 3 inc, 3 sc (9)
 - 5-6. (2 rounds) 3 inc, 3 dec. Cut black, join yellow (9)
 7. With yellow, (2 sc, inc) x 3 (12)
 - 8-9. (2 rounds) 12 sc (12)
 10. 5 sc, 2 inc, 3sc, inc, sc (15)
 - 11-12. (2 rounds) 15 sc (15)
 13. (4 sc, inc) x 3 (18)
 - 14-15. (2 rounds) 18 sc (18)
- Fasten off and leave a long tail to join to the head. Weave in ends

Stuff ears loosely and attach to the head. Embroider spiral eyes, cheek spots, and mouth
because of the imperfect and scribbled design of Mimikyu's face, there is really no wrong way to do this. Put the facial features wherever you want

Body

1. With black, 8 sc into MR (8) *leave a long tail on the outside of the body to be used for anchoring the head later (12in or more)*
2. 8 inc (16)
3. (sc, inc) x 8 (24)
4. (2 sc, inc) x 8 (32)
5. (3 sc, inc) x 8 (40)
6. 40 sc. Cut black, join yellow (40)
7. With yellow, BLO (4 sc, inc) x 8 (48)

- 8. BLO (48)
- 9-12. (4 rounds) 48 sc (48)
- 13. (4 sc, dec) x 8 (40)
- 14-16. (3 rounds) 40 sc (40)
- 17. (3 sc, dec) x 8 (32)
- 18. 32 sc (32)
- 19. (2sc, dec) x 8 (24)
- 20-25. (6 rounds) 24 sc (24)

Fasten off and weave in ends. Stuff firmly at the bottom and loosely at the top for the head to be floppy. Weighted plastic pellets can be added to the bottom of the body to help prevent the toy from falling over due to the weight of the head

Body Frills

- 1. Black front loops: (4 sc, inc) x 8 (48)
- 2. (5 sc, inc) x 8 (56)
- 3. tc, dc, hdc, slip, (slip, hdc, dc, tc, dc, hdc, slip) x 7, slip, hdc, dc (56)

Fasten off and weave in ends

- 1. Yellow front loops: (5 sc, inc) x 8 (56)
- 2. (slip, hdc, dc, tc, dc, hdc, slip) x 8 (56)

Fasten off and weave in ends

With black, embroider little eyes onto the body

Sew head onto the body

Anchoring the Head

Since the head doesn't flop over on its own, thread the black body tail from the MR through a long needle and poke it through the top right part of the body near round 20, thread it horizontally through 1-2 stitches on the bottom right side of the head near round 22, and poke it back through where it came out of the body and through the bottom where the MR starts. Pull tight so the head and body are touching and no thread is exposed. Tie off with a knot and weave in end.

Tail

- 1. With brown, 8 sc into MR (8) *leave a long tail to attach to body*
- 2-4. (3 rounds) 8 sc (8)
- 5-6. (2 rounds) ch 1, turn, 4 sc (8)
- 7. 4 inc, 4 sc (12)
- 8-9. (2 rounds) (sc, inc) x 3, 3 dec (12)
- 10. 9 sc, ch 1, turn, 6 sc (12)
- 11. ch 1, turn, 6 sc (12)

If using a marker, remove marker and place at BOR. This is your new BOR

12. sc, 4 inc, 7 sc (16)

13-14. (2 rounds) (sc, inc) x 4, 4 dec (16)

15-18. (4 rounds) 16 sc (16)

19. (2 sc, dec) x 4 (12)

20. 6 dec (6)

Do not stuff tail. Fasten off and weave in end

Sew the tail onto the body
